Sunday Evening Message Series—

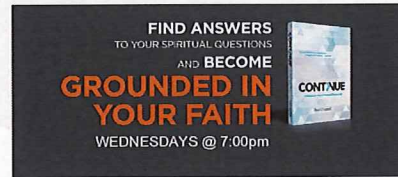
