We need to learn this secret of the burning heart. 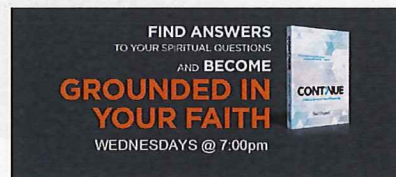
#### Ladies Bible Study - Fridays in the Fellowship Hall - 9:30am
